2021 Wild West Shootout IMPORTANT Guidelines – COVID 19

We ask everyone attending the Wild West Shootout to consider the health and safety guidelines for this event and to be considerate to those near you. We require everyone to follow the approved local and state guidelines throughout the tournament (below). In addition, important signs will be posted at the tournament that must be followed at all times.

- Coaches are responsible for ensuring all players and their spectators adhere to all requirements.
- All Coaches and spectators are required to wear face coverings, follow the social distance guidelines, and sit in the designated areas only.
- Arrival: Coaches and Players can arrive 45 minutes before their scheduled game time. All spectators can arrive 15 minutes before game time.
- Departure: As soon as the game is over, all players and spectators should leave the field area to allow the next team to take the field.
- Coaches will be responsible for pre-game equipment player checks for their team.
- Players are required to wear a mask to and from the fields and when not playing.
- Players may not share equipment or water bottles
- Team Seating: Teams will sit on opposite ends of the field on the same sideline.
- Game balls will be provided for each game. Teams must bring their own equipment.
- No coin toss, teams will line up in starting positions and the home team will kick-off.
- No Pre/Post Game handshakes or high fives. Teams are encouraged to show sportsmanship with social distancing in mind.
- ALL players, coaches and spectators must stay home if they are sick or test positive for COVID-19
- If any issues arise with these procedures the referee or tournament staff has the right to stop the game for a compliance warning further noncompliance will render a forfeit and possible ejection from the event.
